

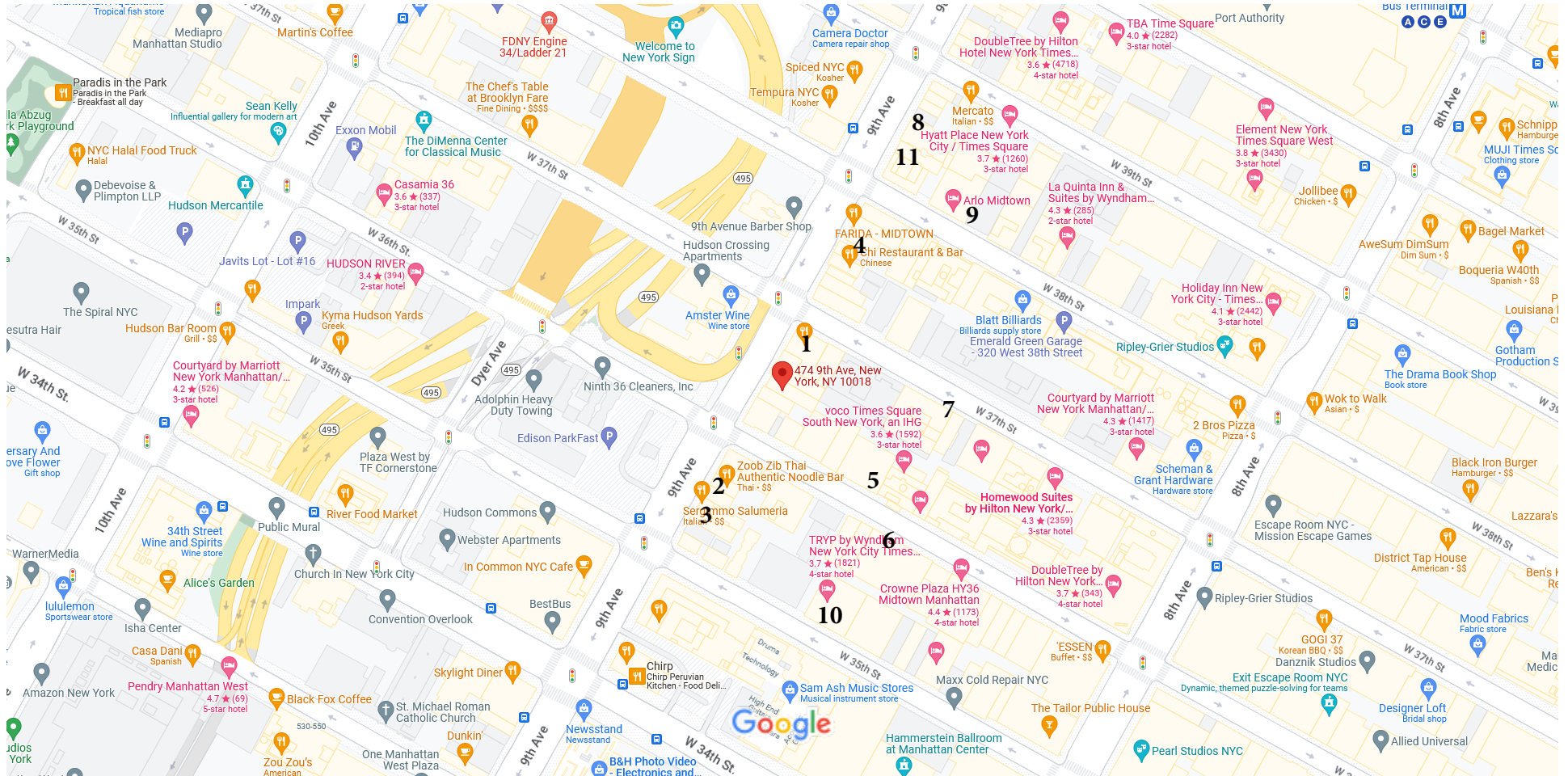

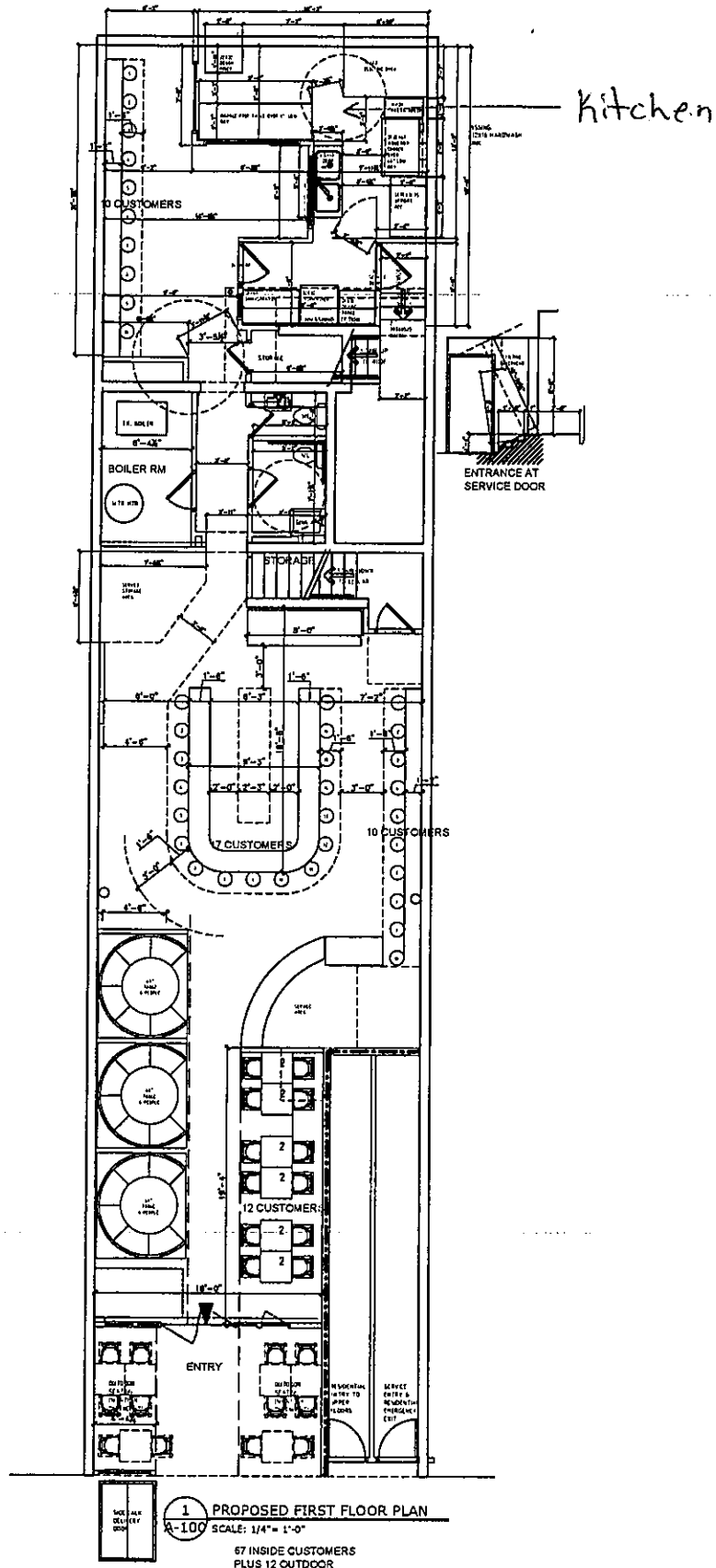

STATEMENT OF PUBLIC INTEREST

One of the principals of the applicant operates two other full service Italian restaurants in the immediate area and thus is well acquainted with the community and its desires. The applicant will serve those who live or work in the area, as opposed to tourists or those seeking a full “white table cloth” meal. The menu will be very limited – appetizers, several pasta dishes, and pizza; it is anticipated that there will be a significant take-out/delivery business.

While the area currently has several full service restaurants, which are fairly expensive, at which patrons can have a more formal meal, and a number of bars which do not provide quality food, it has few establishments where someone can eat quickly and inexpensively or get a reasonably priced quality meal. The applicant has been filling that need and has been supporting the business.

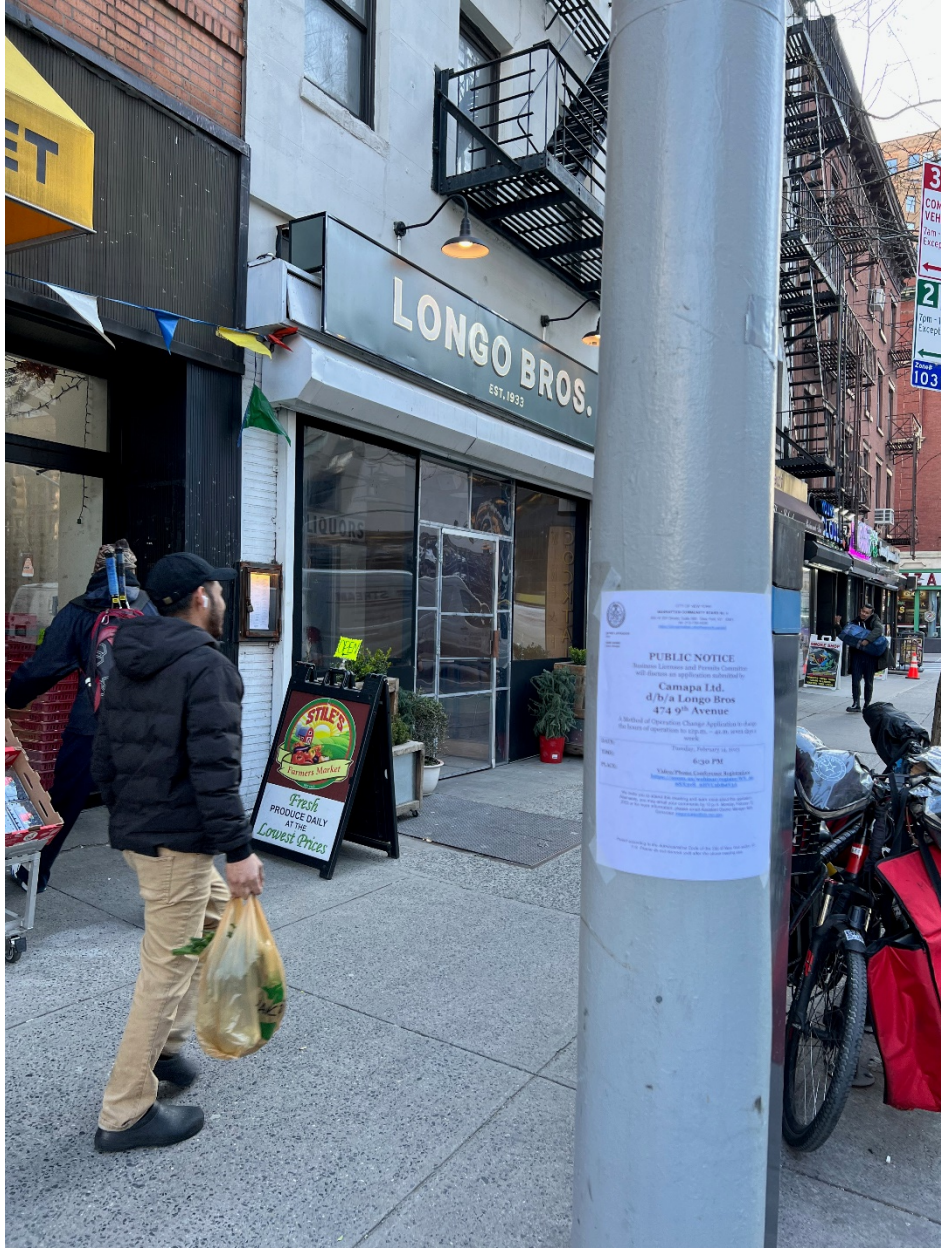
