




INTERIOR DIAGRAM – Basement 160 8th Avenue New York, NY August 7, 2023

PUBLIC INTEREST STATEMENT / 500' LAW STATEMENT

Andreas CH LLC dba Da Andrea 160 Eighth Avenue New York, New York 10011

Andreas CH LLC will be applying for a full liquor license at 160 Eighth Avenue between West 18th and West 17th Streets. Da Andrea will be a casual Italian restaurant. This will be the sister restaurant of Da Andrea located at 35 West 13th Street that has been opened since July 2019 to August 2020 with a beer and wine license and then with a full liquor license from August 2020 to the present.

The former restaurant that occupied the space was Mexicue 160 8th Avenue LLC dba Mexicue from 2017 to August 2023 and before that the space was a restaurant occupied by Pounds & Ounces LLC dba Studio Kraut from 2012 to 2017.

The interior of the new restaurant will have 48 tables with 129 seats together with a 27'-8" x 7'-2" customer bar with 18 bar stools for a total of 144 seats. The proposed hours of operation for the interior are 10am to 12am 7 days a week. There will be background music from 10am to 12am 7 days a week. There will also be live music consisting of light jazz for weekend brunch from 1230pm to 330pm on Saturdays and Sunday.

The exterior space will have roadway seating on West 18th Street with 8 tables and 32 seats. There will be an exterior sidewalk café on West 18th Street with 11 and 22 seats and a sidewalk café on Eighth Avenue with 3 tables and 6 seats for a total of 22 tables and 56 seats. There will be no music in the exterior spaces. The proposed hours of operation are 10am to 10pm Sunday to the Thursday and 10am to 11pm Friday to Saturday.

The menu features high quality dishes such as Risotto with parmesan, scallions and Italian sweet sausage ragout, a pork Tenderloin Milanese, calamaretti with corn and cucumber salad, Tigelle modenesi con prosciutto, cavatelli di ricotta with shrimp and salmon, an artichoke ravioli, penne pasta with eggplant, mozzarella and spicy tomato sauce, a stuffed chicken breast with mozzarella, ham, spinach and rosemary sauce and grilled jumbo shrimp with asparagus and saffron sauce. Desserts include a chocolate walnut cake with salty caramel ice cream, tiramisu and mixed berries with warm zabaion in a puff basket.

The sole owner Abdul Mannan has worked in the hospitality industry since 2004. He worked his way up from a bus boy to a runner and eventually graduated to earn a title as an operations manager. His work experience includes I Tre Merli Bistor as a server and Olio E Piu, first as a floor manager and then as the general manager. He was the operations manager for The Group from August 2016 to July 2019. The Group owns Olio E Piu on Greenwich Avenue, Petite Boucherie on Christopher Street, Boucherie of Seventh Avenue South and Boucherie Union Square on Park Avenue South.

The following sub-sections of section 64 of the ABC Law specifically address the statutory requirements for the public convenience and advantage when there are three or more establishments with full liquor licenses within 500 feet of the applicant:

(a) The number, classes and character of licenses in proximity to the location and in particular municipality or subdivision thereof.

There are sixteen establishments that hold full liquor licenses within 500' of the applicant. There are ten restaurants, five bars and one theater. Lasagna Ristorante is a popular Italian restaurant that is 476' from the applicant and Zizi is a charming Mediterranean restaurant that is 358' from the applicant. Loulou is a casual French restaurant that is 250' from the applicant. Jack's Wife Freda is a popular Continental restaurant that is 496' from the applicant.

Socarrat is a pretty Spanish bar that is 338' from the applicant and Jungle Bird is a bar with modern décor that is 212' from the applicant.

The closest venue to the applicant is Rangoon, a Burmese restaurant that is 30' from the applicant.

Da Andrea will prove to be a favorite neighborhood Italian restaurant in the area as its sister restaurant is on 35 West 13th Street.

(b) Evidence that all necessary licenses and permits have been obtained from the state and all other governing bodies

The premises have a NYC Department of Buildings Certificate of Occupancy showing Use Group 6 with occupancy for 175. The applicant will obtain all necessary inspections and permits, including but not limited to a Department of Health and Mental Hygiene permit and necessary Fire Department Inspections. The applicant will obtain a NYS Certificate of Authority to Collect Sales Taxes and a Certificate of Assumed Name.

(c) Effect of the grant of the license on vehicular traffic and parking in proximity to the location

The space has been operating as a full-service restaurant for many years and guests can take public transportation to the venue since there are a number of NYC buses and subways that are accessible to the area. Guests can also take NYC taxis and private car services. Local residents can also walk to the restaurant. The venue is a destination for residents of the New York City area, business professionals and tourists from nearby hotels and not a destination establishment for individuals to travel to for cocktails. We do not anticipate a negative impact on vehicular traffic.

(d) The existing noise level at the location and any increase in noise levels that would be generated by the proposed premises

The establishment will only have background music and light jazz for weekend brunch. The restaurant will only have 8 to 10 small speakers located in the walls. If requested, we will install ATS acoustic panels. Since the venue has been licensed for many years, we therefore do not anticipate an increase in noise levels at the premises and the issuance of a full liquor license will not increase noise levels in the area.

(e) The history of liquor violations and reported criminal activity at the proposed premises

Upon information and belief; and to the best of our knowledge there are no current SLA violations for this space. To the best of our knowledge there is no known history of criminal activity at the premises.

In addition to the matters stated above, issuance of the instant license will promote the public interest in that it will be a positive contribution to the economy by way of the jobs maintained, continued wages paid, income, sales and other taxes collected, state and local license revenues, and maintenance of the local real estate tax base.

Accordingly, we believe approval of this removal application and issuance of an on-premises liquor license will promote the public interest and convenience. We therefore request that the Community Board approve the application.
