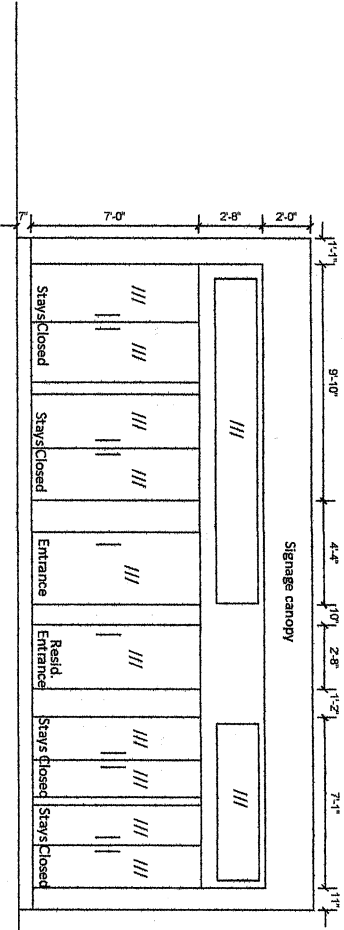

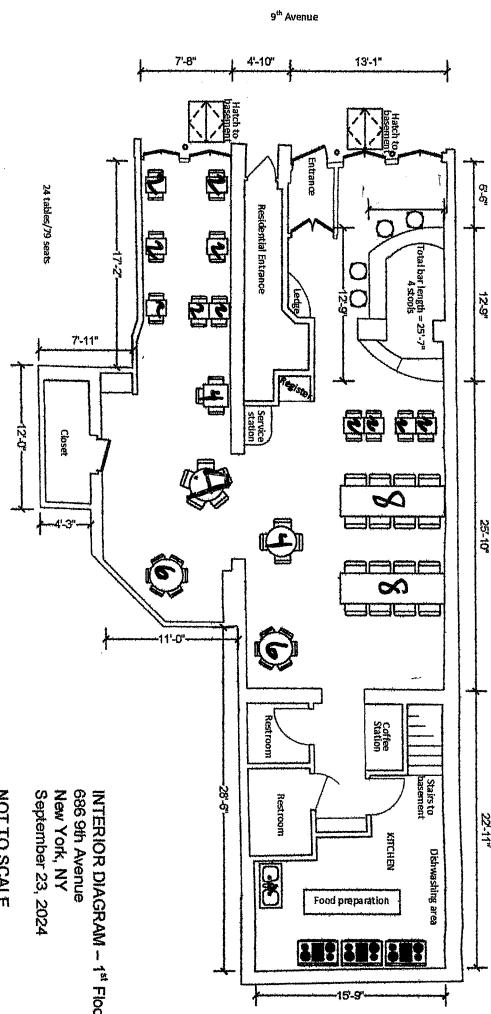

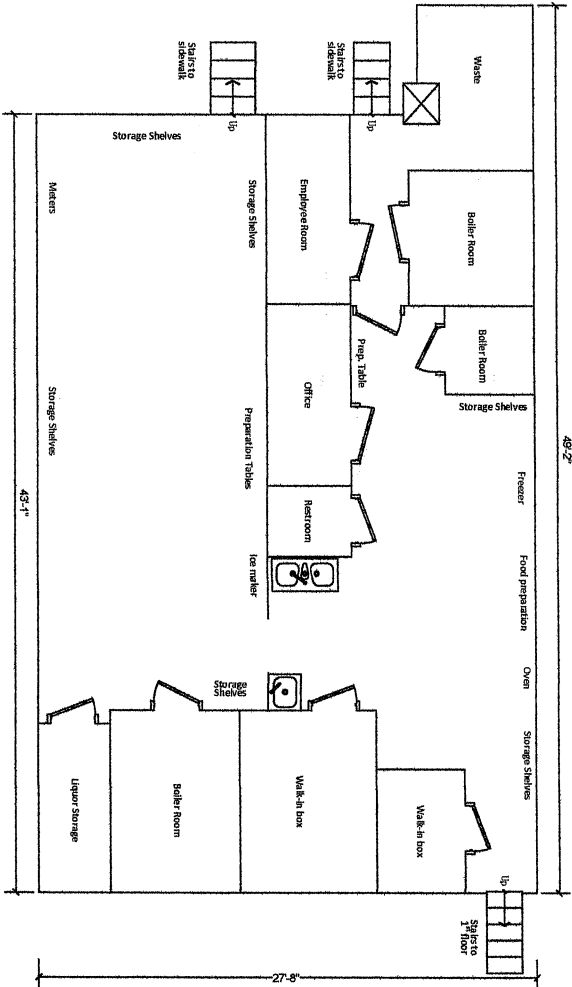


FRONT ELEVATION


