
PUBLIC INTEREST STATEMENT

The issuance of this license will serve the public interest for the following reasons:


- 1) This establishment will continue to provide the community with a restaurant that will provide quality food with a warm and welcoming atmosphere with excellent service and an appealing ambiance.

- 6) This establishment will provide valuable tax revenue to both New York City & New York State.


