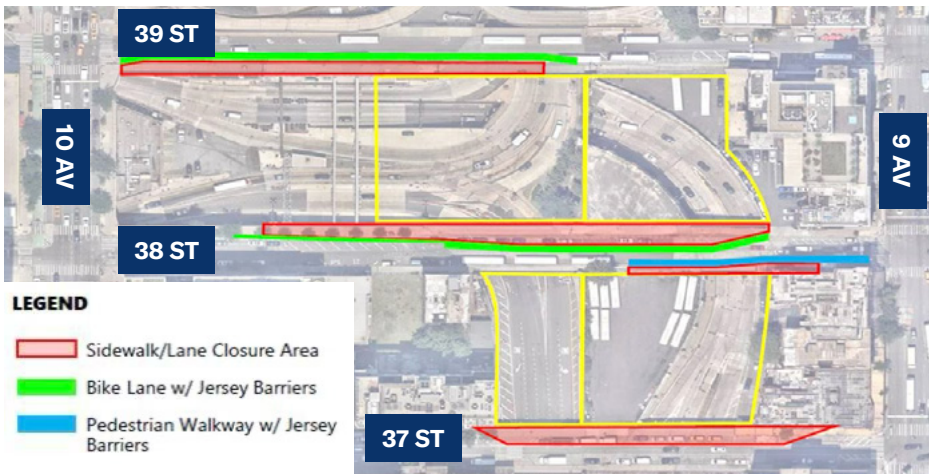




# A WHOLE NEW BUS TERMINAL

## DYER DECK OVER MAINTENANCE AND PROTECTION OF TRAFFIC PLAN

The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey (PANYNJ) is committed to providing for the safe and orderly flow of motor vehicles, bicycles, and pedestrians through the work area for the Dyer Deck Over phase (Phase 1A) of the Midtown Bus Terminal Replacement program while simultaneously providing for the safety of all construction workers in or adjacent to roadways. To ensure these goals, PANYNJ will be implementing its maintenance and protection of traffic (MPT) plan in the coming weeks\*. This plan will entail changes to the roadways and sidewalks within the area bounded by 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue, West 39<sup>th</sup> Street and West 37<sup>th</sup> Street. These changes will remain in effect for the entirety of Phase 1A.



### WORK HOURS:

#### WEEKDAYS 7:00 AM–3:30 PM

Planned work this period to establish MPT on 37<sup>th</sup>, 38<sup>th</sup> and 39<sup>th</sup> Street.

#### WEEKNIGHTS 11:00 PM–5:00 AM (Periodic as needed in Lower Level)

Install Barriers to Establish Temporary Work Zones at lower levels. All other work within Work Zones complete by 7am.

39 <sup>th</sup> Street	Two travel lanes reduced to one to accommodate bicycle access; Temporary Protected Bicycle Lane protected by barriers in south lane of roadway	No closures; will accommodate all pedestrian traffic	Closed from 10 <sup>th</sup> Avenue to Dyer Avenue
38 <sup>th</sup> Street	One travel lane; North side parking removed from 160 feet east of 10 <sup>th</sup> Avenue to 120 feet west of 9 <sup>th</sup> Avenue; Temporary bicycle lane protected by barriers in this stretch of roadway	Closed to pedestrians from 160 feet east of 10 <sup>th</sup> Avenue to 120 feet west of 9 <sup>th</sup> Avenue; all pedestrian traffic shifts to south side	Closed for 250 feet west of 9 <sup>th</sup> Avenue; Pedestrian walkway protected by jersey barriers from western end of sidewalk closure to 9 <sup>th</sup> Avenue
37 <sup>th</sup> Street	One travel lane; parking lane on north side of roadway removed	Closed for 450 feet west of 9 <sup>th</sup> Avenue	No changes

\* Actual construction of the Dyer Deck Overs will begin at a later date. A separate advisory will follow for the construction work.
