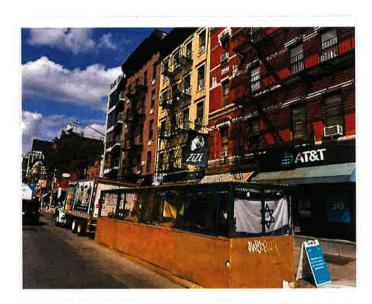

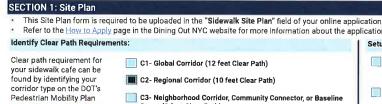












Pedestrian Demand Map.

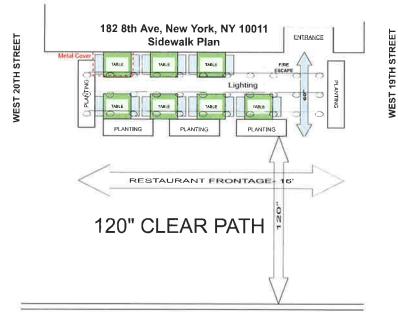

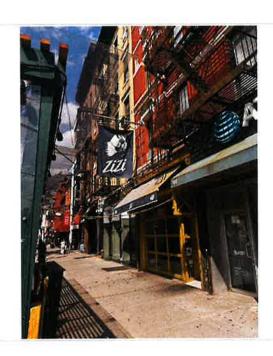

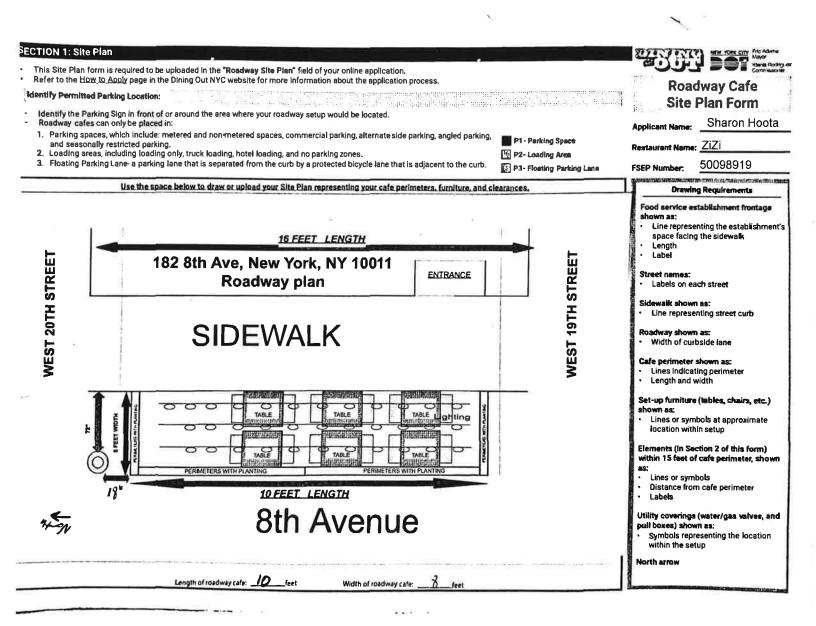
