

2. EVIDENCE THAT ALL NECESSARY LICENSES AND PERMITS HAVE BEEN OBTAINED FROM THE STATE AND ALL OTHER GOVERNING BODIES:

All necessary licenses and permits either have or will be obtained by the applicant.

3. EFFECT OF THE GRANT OF THE LICENSE ON VEHICULAR TRAFFIC AND PARKING IN PROXIMITY TO THE LOCATION:

Basically, the transaction underlying the liquor license application is the result of Steve Tenedios transferring to Eliezer Weiss his interest in the entity which owns the Hudson Bar Room. Other than for a change in the trade name and a refurbishment of the premises, there will be no change in the operation of the business. 444 AS Lounge LLC will not impact traffic or parking in or around the area and it will not alter traffic patterns. Most of the patrons will be hotel guests or pedestrians who arrive either by foot or through mass transit.

4. THE EXISTING NOISE LEVEL AT THE LOCATION AND ANY INCREASE IN NOISE LEVELS THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY THE PROPOSED PREMISES:

444 AS Lounge LLC will not impact local noise levels. Audio is kept within legal decibel limits and noise is not noticeable on the street or outside the premises.

5. THE HISTORY OF LIQUOR VIOLATIONS AND REPORTED CRIMINAL ACTIVITY AT THE PROPOSED PREMISES:

444 As Lounge LLC has no history of either liquor license violations or criminal activity. The current licensee did have one violation at the Liquor Authority in May 2019 resulting in a fine of \$500.

6. ANY OTHER FACTORS SPECIFIC BY LAW OR REGULATION THAT ARE RELEVANT TO DETERMINE THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND ADVANTAGE AND PUBLIC INTEREST OF THE COMMUNITY:

444 AS Lounge LLC will provide an alternative to tourists, local business people and the community and will provide employment and will pay taxes. previous business at the premises, the Hudson Bar Room, was open for several years and was well received by the community.
