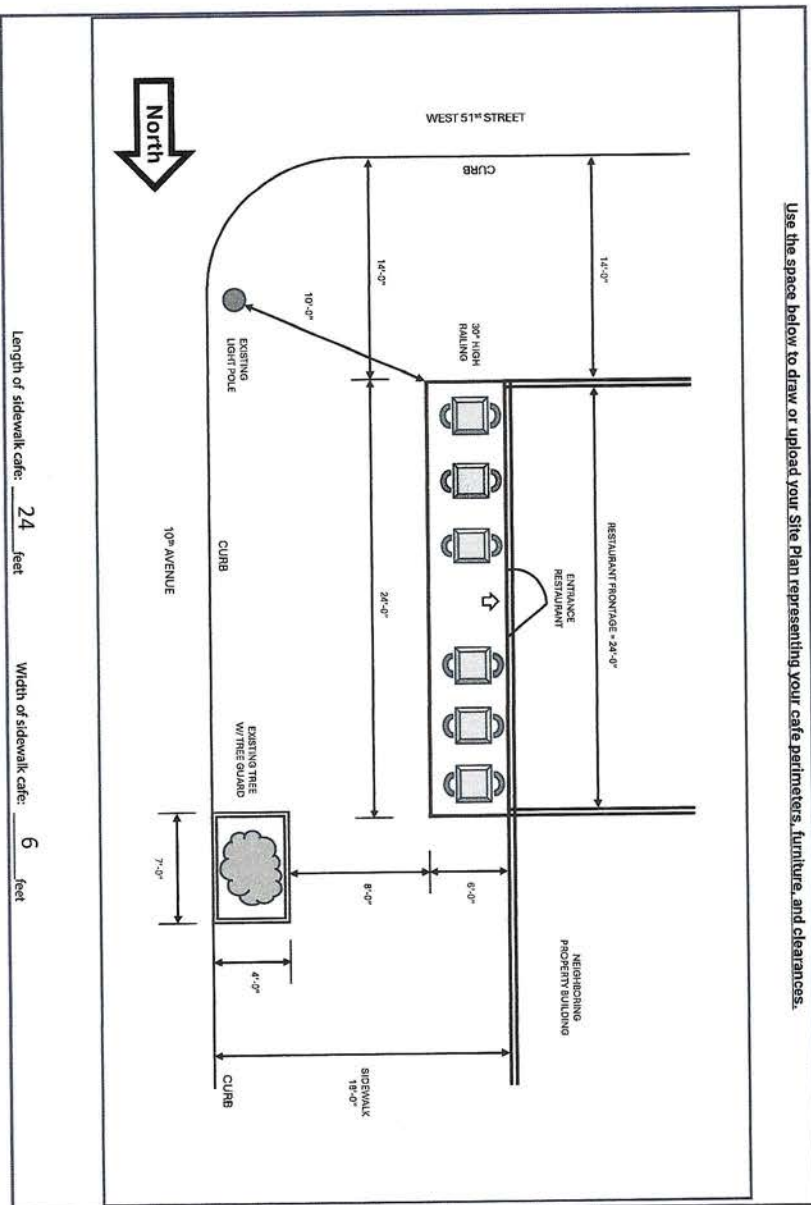

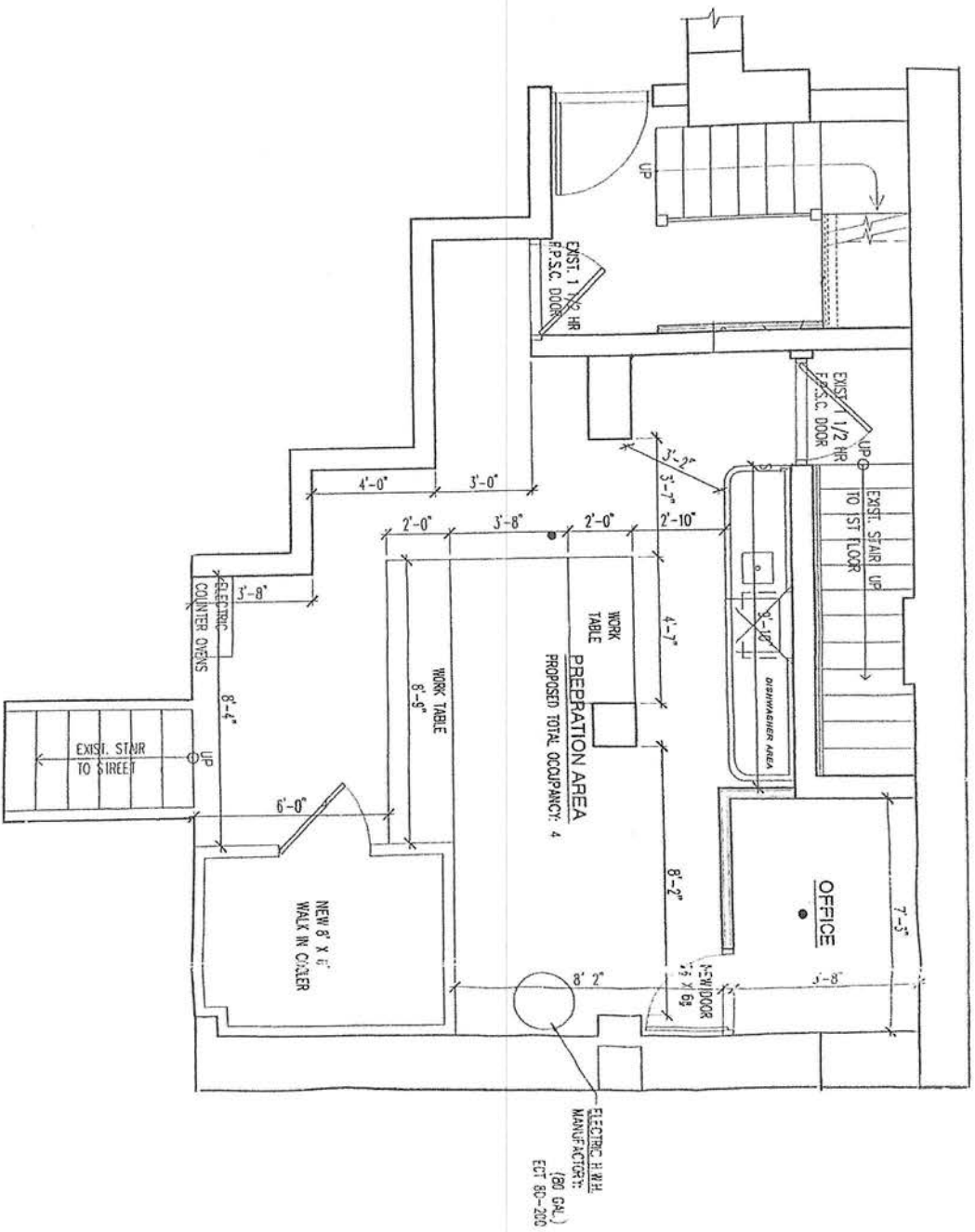
Sixtily LLC - GROUND FLOOR DIAGRAM
