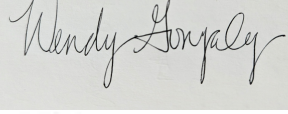

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Trump Vows to Aid Europe In Hastening Arms to Kyiv

He Warns of 'Very Severe Tariffs' for Russia
if Peace Deal Isn't Done in 50 Days

WASHINGTON — President Trump said on Monday that he would help Europe speed up the flow of weapons to Ukraine and warned Russia that it would face "very severe tariffs" if a peace deal was not reached in 50 days.

The announcement comes as Mr. Trump faces a new round of criticism from some Republicans who say he is not doing enough to support Ukraine.

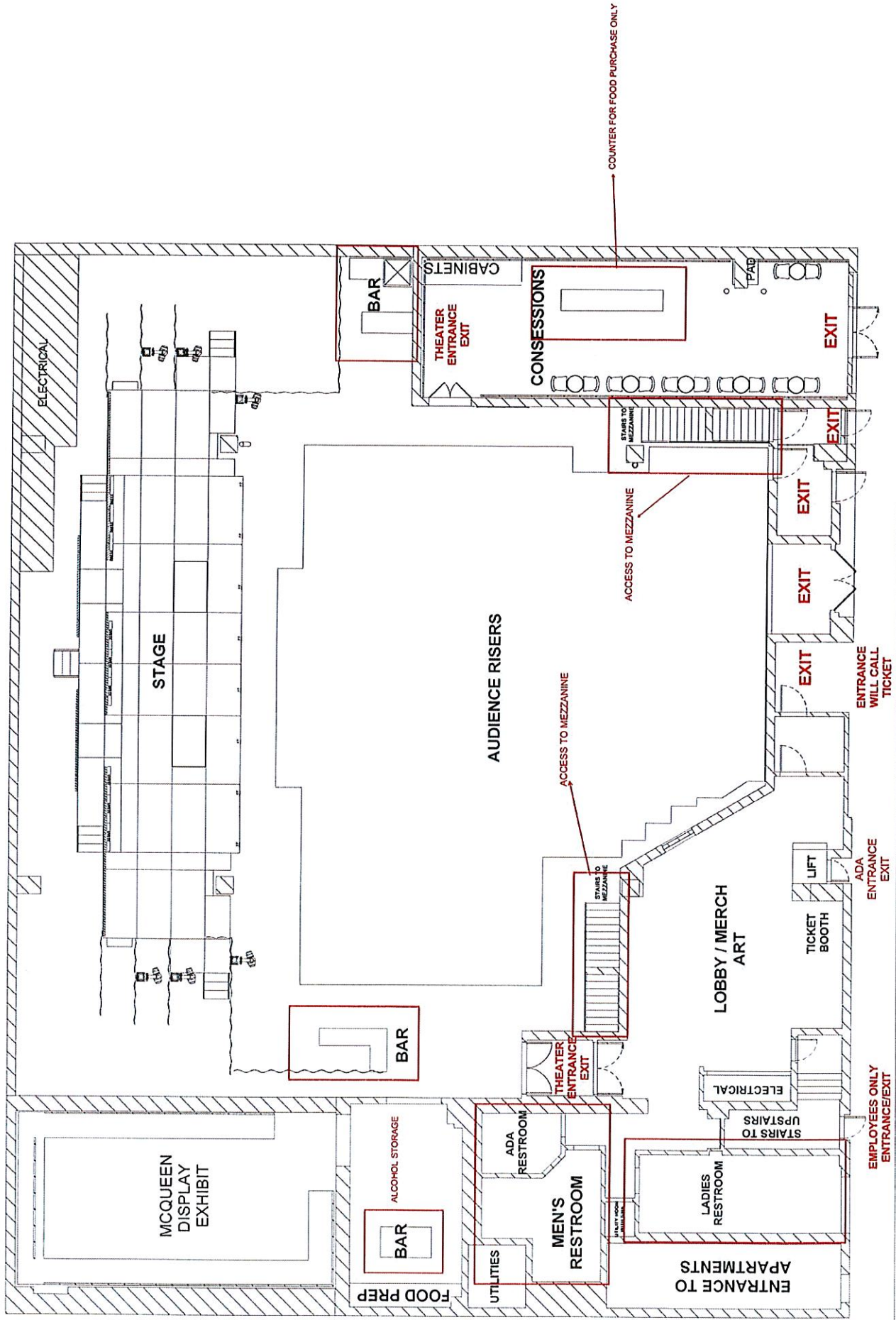
Mr. Trump said he was in the White House to make a decision about the tariffs. He said he would be making a decision about the tariffs in the next few days.

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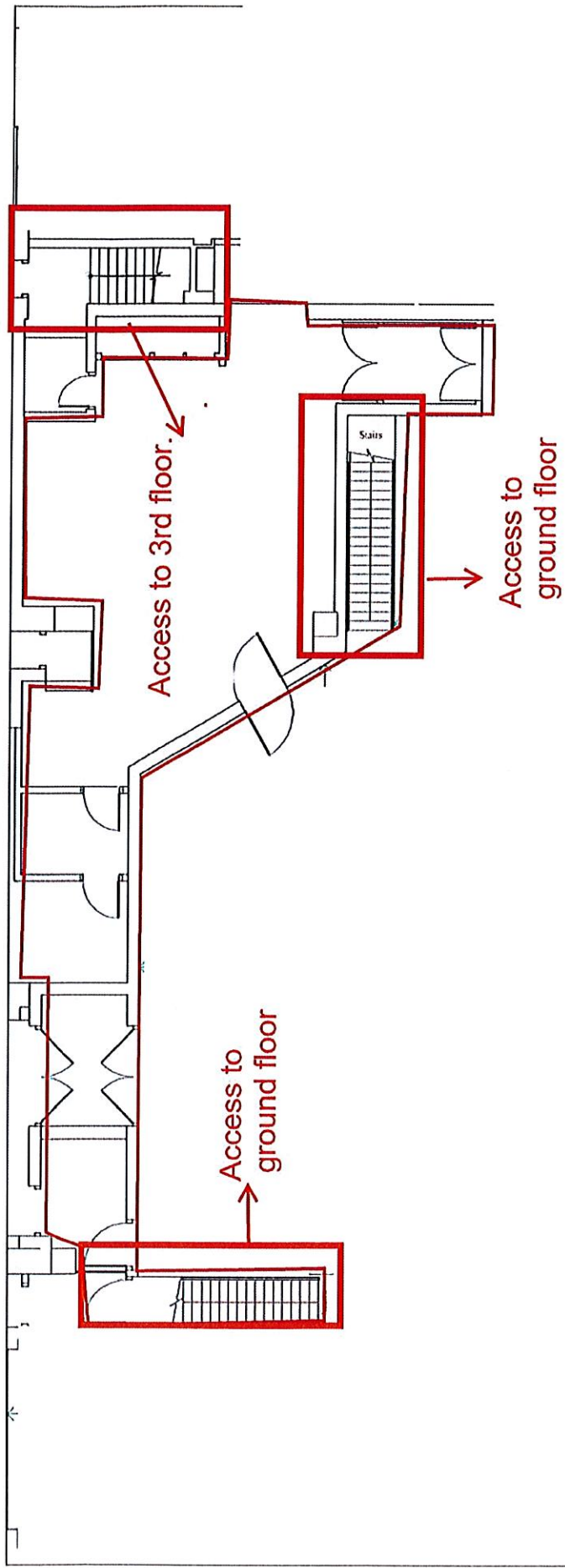
