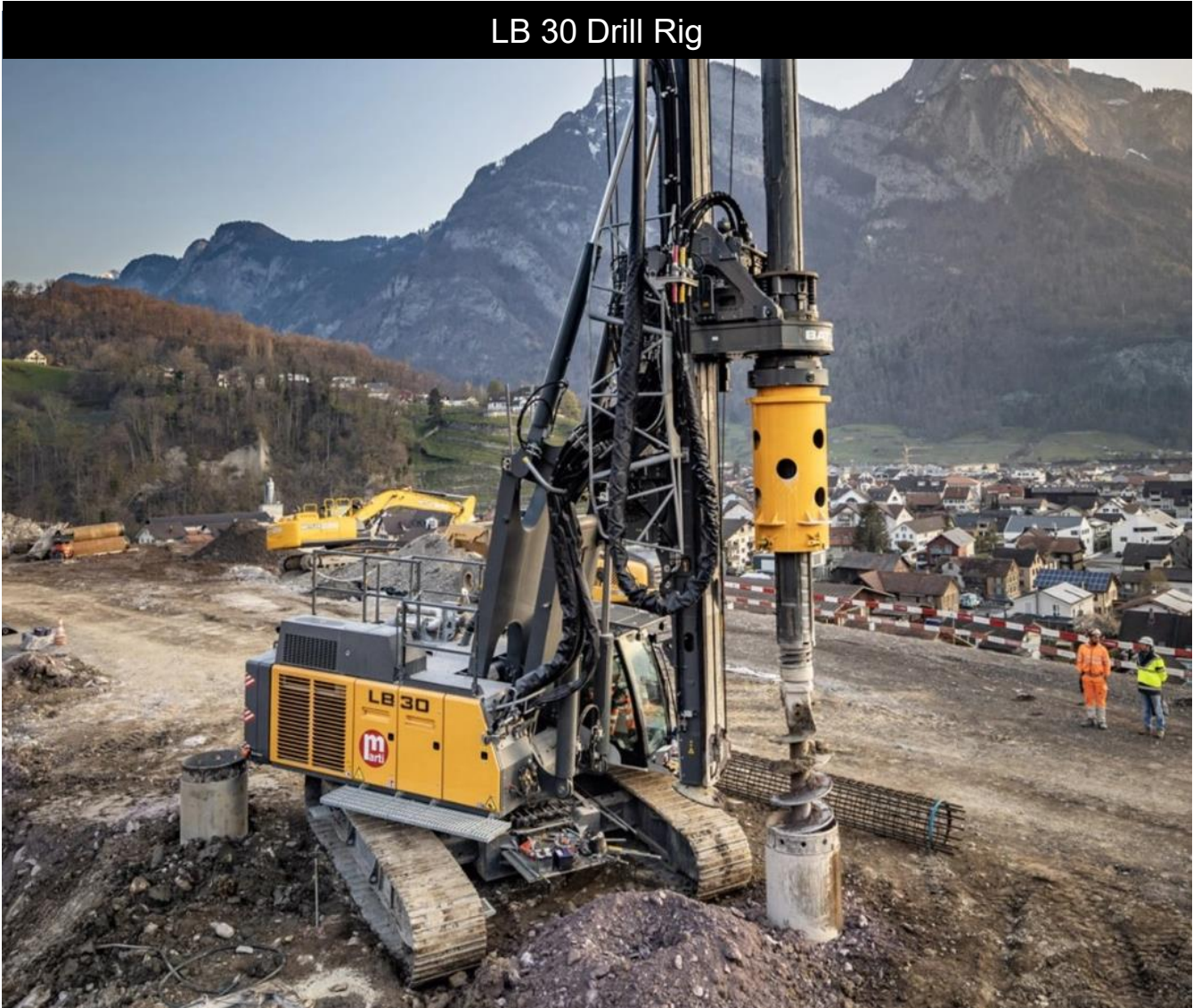


**Street Level**

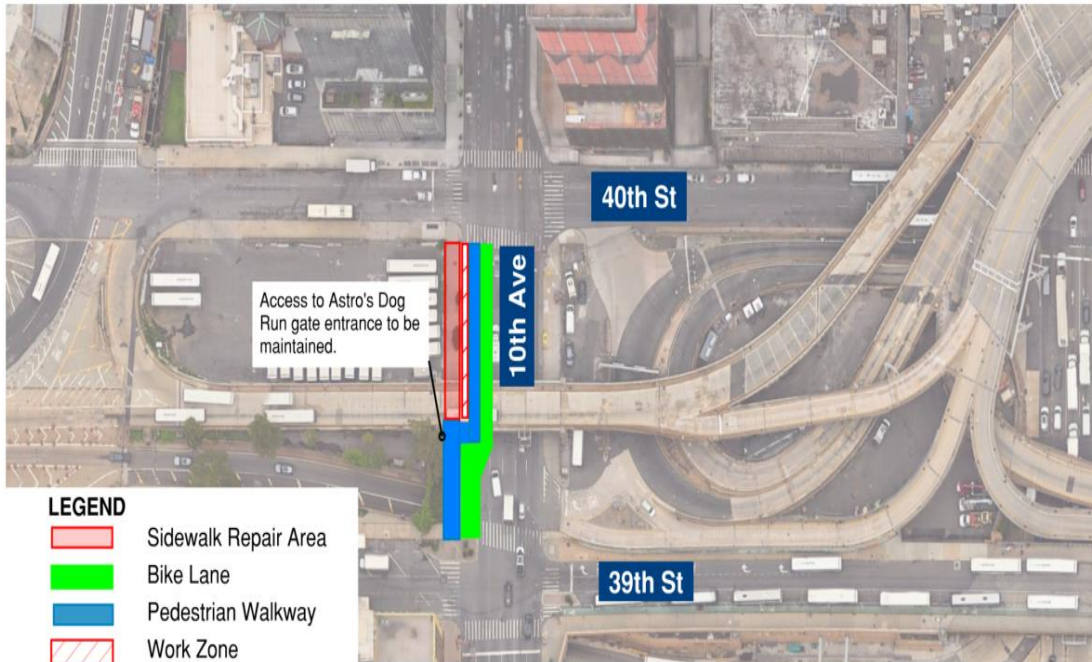

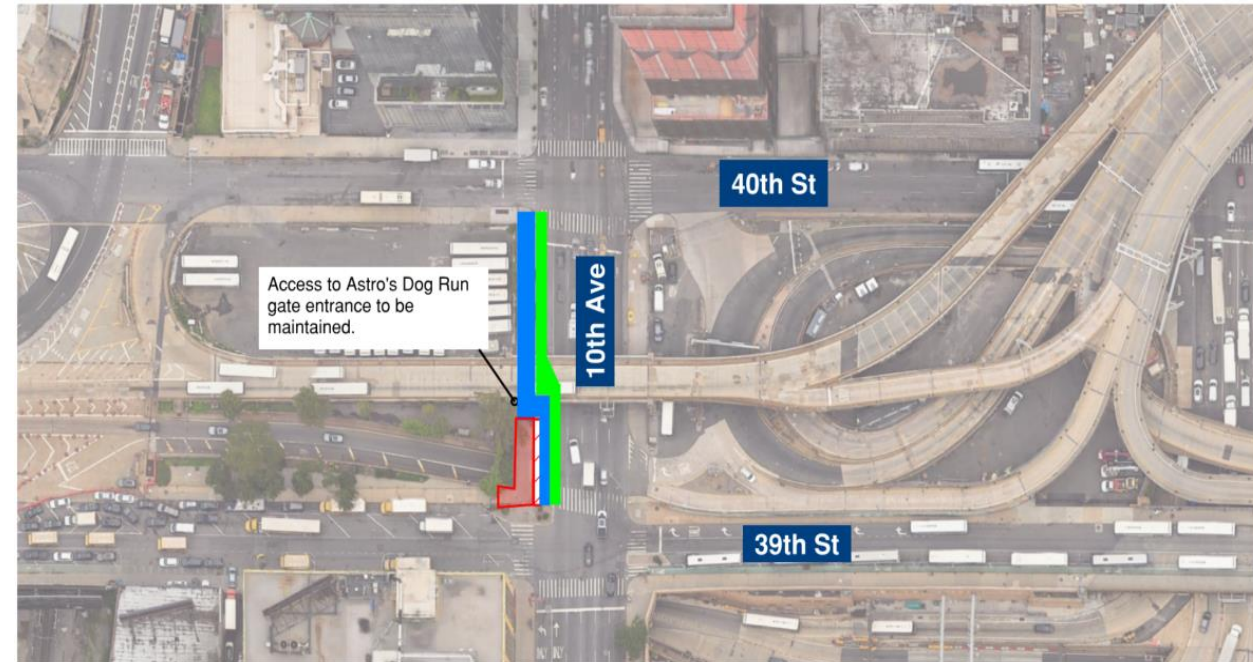

# Sidewalk Repairs: 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue between 39<sup>th</sup> and 40<sup>th</sup> Streets

- **Purpose & Need:** Repair of sidewalks on 10th Avenue between 39th Street and 40th Street, including sidewalk and curb repair, replacement, and installation, and ensure that sidewalks are safe for pedestrians.
- **Timeline:** Project will start very soon and span approx. 8-12 weeks in total encompassing all three phases.

# Sidewalk Repairs: 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue at 40<sup>th</sup> Street

- **Purpose & Need:** Replace and install new ADA sidewalk ramp on 11th Avenue at 40th Street, consistent with NYCDOT design standards.
- **Timeline:** Project will start soon and span approx. 8-12 weeks in total encompassing all three phases.
