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
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Jack's Wife Freda is the creation and on going work of husband & wife - Dean's Wife Maya (& Dean), and a growing group of exceptional staff, friends and family.





Jack's Wife Freda sounds like a character in a Barry Levinson film or maybe a Bernard Malamud novel. Instead, it's a spiffy new Soho café, where the husband-and-wife owners have drawn on their New York restaurant backgrounds and their family histories to bring appealing new flavor to an urban archetype. Before they met while working at Balthazar, Dean Jankelowitz and his future wife, Maya, emigrated from South Africa and Israel, respectively. Together, they've created a hospitable hangout with the understated style and savvy all-day service that one associates with their old boss, Keith McNally, only infused with their warm, welcoming personalities and foods that remind them of home. (Jack and Freda were Dean's grandparents.)

The food at Jack's Wife Freda, you see, is homey, delicious, and wonderfully satisfying. If you were going to give it a long and unwieldy name, it might be South African Israeli Jewish Grandmother Cuisine, and there's no better introduction to it than Freda's fried fish balls. Here are five bite-size fritters made from smoked whitefish and hake, finely ground and panko-crusted, then deep-fried to a crisp and served with horseradish aïoli. It's gefilte fish for the McNugget set. Equally snackable are the "peri-peri" giblets, a South African shout-out via braised and fried chicken livers and gizzards seasoned with chiles that grow there; thick rounds of fried zucchini to dunk in smoked-paprika aïoli; and a toothsome slab of char-grilled haloumi cheese, garnished with grapes and tiny toasts. Freda's matzo-ball soup is a soothing house specialty, and the Greek salad is constructed, as are an increasing number of winter salads these days, with crunchy fresh kale.

The Jankelowitzes always worked front of the house, which might be why they seem to know four out of every five customers who cross the threshold and to greet them with kisses and bear hugs.


Maya and Dean Jankelowitz, both veterans of the Keith McNally universe (Balthazar, Schillers, respectively) have spun off their own creation called <u>Jack's Wife Freda</u>. JWF, which just opened on Spring street, seems to be an instant neighborhood joint. Named after Dean's grandparents, the breakfast-to-dinner cafe serves the Israeli (Maya) and South African (Dean) comfort food the couple has come to love.


And it really is homey. Already Jack's Wife Freda has regulars, and as I sat trying to talk with Maya she kept getting up to say hello to newcomers, and make people feel welcome. One such regular even told me the fittingly charming secret to the key lime pie dessert special: the sous chef's wife, a city planner, comes to the restaurant after work to bake the pies so she can hang out with her husband. The place has created some good buzz since opening. The Village Voice noted their <u>Zucchini Chips</u> ("Once you pop, you just won't stop"). Serious Eats highlighted their <u>rosewater waffles</u>. New York magazine dubbed the food <u>South African Israeli Jewish Grandmother Cuisine</u>, and that JWF had "effortless charm and simple, delicious grub." It's a sort of elevated comfort food — everything is familiar but has a twist, like soft-boiled eggs served with challah "soldiers", or the peri-peri giblets, which are sublimely prepared gizzards and liver. Being comfy and cozy and cash (is that the correct shorthand for casual?) was essential to Maya and Dean. "It's really important to me that people feel that it's not 'cool'," she says, "that they can come with their parents, they can come with their boyfriend, they can come on a date, they can come by themselves. Just not intimating but comfortable. I don't know if it's like that in Paris, but when you go into cafes it's not a big deal. There are so many cafes. You go in, you know that the food is decent, and that's it! I t's not like a big deal."







