## **Re:** Parking Regulations on 15<sup>th</sup> Street and Ninth Avenue

Dear Commissioner Forgione:

Manhattan Community Board 4 (CB4) requests that the Department of Transportation install "No Standing, except Trucks Loading and Unloading, 6am to 6pm", on the south side of 15<sup>th</sup> Street, between Ninth Avenue and the western boundary of the Prince Lumber property.

The south side of the block is one of the few remaining manufacturing sections in the city. Because the current parking regulations are unclear, delivery trucks have received summonses, which bring unwarranted hardship on the business and its customers.

The new signs will clarify the parking regulations and ensure appropriate location of pick-up and delivery of lumber, in the manufacturing area and off Ninth Avenue.
