Dear Chairman Rosen:

Manhattan Community Board 4 (MCB4) recommends denial of a new on premise liquor license for **Angelic Foods Inc d/b/a Blue Dog Coffee Bar and Bakery** as a full service restaurant and bar, unless the following stipulations, agreed to by the applicant, are part of the method of operation for this establishment with a total capacity of 40, with 30 seats and one service bar:

- Hours of operation will be 7:00 a.m.-2:00 a.m. seven days a week. This is an extension of existing hours of operation.
- Kitchen will be open the same hours as restaurants
- There will be background music.
- If French doors are installed, they will close at 10:00 p.m. Sundays through Thursdays and at 11:00 p.m. Fridays and Saturdays, and whenever amplified music is played.
- The applicant agrees not use a storm vestibule enclosure.

A signed copy of the stipulations and community agreements is enclosed. This application is for an on-premise liquor license to be used at a restaurant and bar located at 101 West 25<sup>th</sup> Street, New York, NY.
