Dear Speaker Quinn and President Grillo:

The Housing, Health and Human Service Committee of Manhattan Community Board 4 held a meeting with parents and representatives of P.S. 51 at its monthly meeting on April 21, 2011 to continue discussion of their concerns regarding the school construction.

The purpose of this letter is to request<sup>1</sup> that a meeting of the Steering Committee/Construction Task Force be held as soon as possible with a wider representation of parents by inviting the PTA and the parent group Fight for 51 to discuss the construction. The best time for this meeting would be one week after the start of foundation excavation. The parents have described increasing disruptions during demolition and they are urging the DOE and the City to postpone construction until the school's summer recess.
