Dear Chairman Rosen:

Manhattan Community Board 4 (MCB4) recommends <u>denial</u> of an alteration/upgrade to a full liquor license to Xai Xai Wine Bar LLC <u>unless</u> the following stipulations, agreed to by the applicant, are part of their method of operation:

- Hours of operation will be no earlier than 3:00 p.m. and no later than 2:00 a.m. seven days a week.
- The applicant stated they will have background music playing in the restaurant.
- There will be French doors and/or windows that will be kept closed permanently.
- Delivery bikes will not be used.
- Applicant will not install a storm vestibule enclosure that will project more than 18 inches as per DOB code. Storm enclosures can only be used between November 15th and April 15th.
- Kitchen exhaust will exit through ventilation above the highest floor of surrounding buildings and be constructed in a manner to not disturb neighboring residents or offices. Additionally it will be compliant with NY DOB code.

• There will be no other changes in method of operation.

This is a restaurant that will have a capacity of no more than 88, with 14 tables and 39 seats, and one Stand-up bar with seven seats. A signed copy of the original letter with stipulations, and aforementioned stipulation agreed to by the applicant is enclosed on the MCB4 form.
