Dear Chairman Rosen:

Manhattan Community Board 4 (MCB4) recommends <u>denial</u> of the application of the Metropolitan Arts & Antiques Ltd. to alter its existing catering liquor license to cover the second floor of the building in which it currently occupies a number of other floors unless the following stipulations, agreed to by the applicant, are part of the method of operation:

- Hours of operation will vary depending on the event
- This establishment will have a capacity of no more than 300 people
- The applicant will not use outside promoters.
- Only soft background music not audible from outside the establishment will be played on a regular basis.
- On occasion live amplified music will be used and at those times windows will be closed as per law.

A signed copy of the stipulations is enclosed. This is an existing catering establishment expanding its operations from the floors it currently occupies to an additional floor in the same building. No one appeared in opposition to this application and complaints in the Board's files regarding the existing operations were resolved to the satisfaction of the parties involved.
