No one appeared in opposition to the plans. The applicant was advised that sidewalk cafes are not permitted on the Westside of 8th Avenue, according to Department of City Planning Zoning regulations. The applicant agreed to limit the number of tables to only those planned for the 48th Street side.

Under this condition, the full Board approved this application at its June 5, 2002 meeting.
