At its July 24, 2002 Full Board meeting, Manhattan Community Board No. 4 voted not to approve the pending application for an enclosed sidewalk café by Chez Josephine, 414 West 42nd Street.

The Board has carefully considered the matter. Members of the Board's Transportation Planning Committee visited the site. We reiterate the position we took in our letter of February 24th 1998, when this matter first arose, that "the aesthetic integrity of the West 42nd Street "Theater Row" view corridor would be compromised by any permanent structure extending onto the sidewalk". As in 1998, we would support an unenclosed café at the site.

We recognize that the City Council in 1998 supported a compromise position in favor of a smaller enclosed café than originally applied for. However, our Board did not take part in the compromise discussions or agree to the end result. We firmly believe our 1998 position was sound.
