At its September 4th meeting, the Business Licenses & Permits Committee of Manhattan Community Board No. 4 approved with stipulations the application of Newton Food and Beverage Inc. d/b/a The Carriage House for an on-premises liquor license at 136 West 18th Street. The stipulations are as follows:

- 1. The premises shall be occupied as a restaurant only.
- 2. Music shall at all times be background music only and the sound shall be maintained at a level that cannot be heard outside the premises.
- 3. Patron use shall be contained within the premises.
- 4. Any windows or French doors at the front or rear of the premises that may be open during hours of operation shall be closed after 10pm.
- 5. Applicant shall have and enforce a patron management plan that will prohibit collection and or queuing outside the restaurant and ensure quiet and quick dispersal of patrons leaving the premises.
- 6. Applicant shall have and enforce a traffic management plan that will prohibit cars, taxis, and limos from double parking, lining up, or in any other way impeding traffic on the 100 block of West 18th Street.
- 7. During construction and operation owners will have a decision-capable manager on the premises who will respond in a timely and effective manner to neighborhood complaints.
