Dear Chair Kelly:

At its September 10th meeting, the Business Licenses and Permits Committee of Manhattan Community Board No. 4 voted to recommend approval of the application for an on-premises liquor license of Mumbai, Inc., d/b/a Mumbai, at 250 West 26th Street, with the following stipulations attached:

Applicant agrees that:

1. Patron queuing will not be allowed outside the premises. Customers arriving for shows will wait in designated areas within the premises.
2. Outside promoters will not be used.
3. After the venue opens, a decision-capable representative from Mumbai will attend the Quality of Life Committee meeting for six months. Applicant will quickly and effectively resolve any problems that arise from the operation.

The club may be within 200 feet of an active entrance of the Fashion Institute of Technology. We request that you perform an investigation to determine whether this is the case.

With the above stipulations, Community Board No. 4 recommends approval of this liquor license. This supersedes our July 25 recommendation of denial which was based on insufficient information.
