At its meeting on March 9, 2004, the Business Licenses and Permits Committee of Manhattan Community Board No. 4, heard the application of Eagle Open Kitchen LLC for an alteration to its on-premises liquor license, wherein a service bar on its unenclosed roof deck would become a patron bar. By a vote of six in favor and two opposed, the Committee recommended approval of this alteration, provided the following stipulations are attached to the altered liquor license.

- 1. Applicant agrees that no music will be played or heard on the roof.
- 2. Applicant agrees that if and when any space in surrounding or nearby buildings becomes residential, applicant will enclose this roof space with a permanent, sound-proof structure.
