Re: Parking regulations on West 52<sup>nd</sup> Street between 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Avenues

Dear Commissioner Forgione:

At its meeting of June 16, 2004, the Transportation Planning Committee of Manhattan Community Board No. 4 heard testimony from a business owner on West 52<sup>nd</sup> Street, between 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Avenues, who appeared before the committee to request a change in the parking regulations on that block.

This block is primarily used for manufacturing and commercial uses, including stables and autorelated businesses. All parking signage is marked "No Parking, Monday through Friday, 8am to 6pm." However, many of the auto-related businesses sometimes need to park a vehicle on the street, while waiting to service it, and are regularly ticketed. As a result of the business-owner's statements, the committee voted to request that DOT conduct a study to determine if some provision to allow limited parking, with provisions for street-cleaning, could be permitted.

At its July 7, 2004 full board meeting, Manhattan Community Board No. 4 voted 34 in favor, 2 opposed, 0 abstaining and 0 present but not eligible to vote, in support of the committee's recommendation.
