At its September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2004 meeting, the Business Licenses and Permits Committee of Manhattan Community Board No. 4 voted to recommend approval of an on-premises liquor license for 355 Restaurant on 14<sup>th</sup> Inc. located at 355 West 14<sup>th</sup> Street. The occupancy will be 200 and the total square footage will be 2,500.

This recommendation is contingent on the owner's agreement to incorporate the following stipulations into its method of operation on its New York State Liquor Authority Application:

- 1. 355 Restaurant on 14<sup>th</sup> Inc shall hire a professional acoustic abatement company with at least five years experience in the field of acoustic abatement to design acoustic abatement for the establishment with the goal of preventing noise and vibration that could disturb the nearby residences and businesses (present and future).
- 2. 355 Restaurant on 14<sup>th</sup> Inc shall follow the recommendations of the acoustic abatement company and incorporate their designs into the construction documents of the renovation.

At its full board meeting on October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2004, Manhattan Community Board No. 4 voted to approve this recommendation with the above stipulations attached.
