At its April 19, 2006 meeting, Manhattan Community Board No. 4's Transportation Planning Committee heard from the above applicant and reviewed plans for an unenclosed sidewalk café. No one appeared in opposition to the renewal. The Committee voted to approve the application to renew the sidewalk café with the following stipulation:

• The restaurant operator will mark the café's outer boundaries on the sidewalk, as required by DCA's sidewalk café regulations. If markings are not in place when the applicant returns to the Board for its next renewal, this committee will recommend denial of the renewal application.

On May 3, 2006 the Full Board approved the application with the above stipulation.
