Community Board 4 submits this letter to the Hudson River Park Trust regarding the temporary relocation of the Trapeze School New York.

Community Board 4 understands the School needs to vacate its current location in the park just south of Canal Street to allow for construction. They wish to temporarily relocate to a site within the park at 33rd street until they are able to move into a more permanent facility on Pier 40.

Community Board 4 has no objection to the Trapeze School temporarily occupying this space at 33rd Street through May 2007. We feel the school will occupy a currently underutilized section of the park and will provide a draw during the relatively quiet winter season. Although the design of the temporary facility is somewhat less than desirable, it does include large windows to afford public viewing of the School's captivating activities.

We wish to emphasize that this temporary location will be used only through May 2007 and will not extend into the summer months. Thank you for keeping Community Board 4 apprised of these changes.
