At the last meeting of the Waterfront & Parks Committee of Manhattan Community Board No 4, the Hell's Kitchen Neighborhood Association advised us that it was seeking a grant from DEC, to be shared with a matching grant from the Office of the Manhattan Borough President, to plant 33 trees along Ninth Avenue from 35th to 40th Street.
