Within 60 days after the conclusion of an approved event, the sponsoring organization or the event manager will submit a written report to the Community Board office (Audit Section of Manhattan Community Board 4 Street Activity Permit Application) with copies of the report to the city.

At its full board meeting on February 6, 2008, Manhattan Community Board 4 voted to approve this recommendation.

The applicant has five business days to appeal the Board’s decision in writing to Christie Huus, Assistant Commissioner, CECM/Street Activity Permit Office, 100 Gold Street, 2nd Floor, New York, NY 10038. If written appeal is not received within the time specified, the applicant shall be deemed as having accepted such decision.
