At its February 20, 2008 meeting, Manhattan Community Board 4's Transportation Planning Committee heard from the above applicant and reviewed the application for renewal of a permit for an unenclosed sidewalk café.

Block Association representatives present at the meeting noted that the sidewalk is frequently crowded with patrons congregating outside the rail to smoke. This situation is of further concern since a bus stop is located a few feet south of the café. Bus riders stepping off the bus back door just in front of the café may have no room to get on the sidewalk.

Therefore, the Committee voted to recommend approval of the application for the sidewalk café with the following stipulations:

- the applicant will designate an employee to ensure that no one congregates in front of the café at any time, and
- the applicant will put up signs on the rail to direct patrons to congregate by north and south of the café.

Manhattan Community Board 4 received a written statement (see attached) dated February 21, 2008 from the applicant agreeing to the above stipulations.

At its meeting on March 5, 2008 the Full Board voted to recommend approval this application with the above stipulations.
