**Re: Go West Entertainment, d/b/a Scores, 533-535 West 27<sup>th</sup> (Tenth/Eleventh)**

Dear Chairman Boyle:

At its March 5, 2008 Full Board meeting, Community Board 4 voted to recommend **denial** of a renewal of a liquor license for the applicant for the following reasons:

- Operator/owner has a number of outstanding violations under investigation by the SLA, which are serious in nature, ranging from post-close alcohol consumption to lewd conduct and prostitution to indecent exposure.
- The outstanding violations were issued over the previous three years of this establishment's operation.

When the board first addressed this issue we were open to reconsidering our decision provided that the outstanding violations were fully adjudicated with proper resolution. This was because the operators/owners of the establishment did appear before the BLP committee, regarding the renewal of this license, upon the committee's request, and the committee felt the operator/owner's appearance demonstrated their commitment to working with the community and resolving the outstanding violations.

March 4, 2008 the State Liquor Authority revoked the liquor license for Go West Entertainment d/b/a Scores, 533-535 West 27<sup>th</sup> Street. We see no reason anymore to reconsider our denial for renewal either now or in the future.
