At its March 19, 2008 meeting, Manhattan Community Board 4’s Transportation Planning Committee heard from the above applicant and reviewed the application for renewal of a permit for an unenclosed sidewalk café. No one appeared in opposition to the application.

The Committee voted unanimously to recommend approval of this application for renewal of the sidewalk café permit.

We continue to request that the outer boundaries of cafes be marked on the sidewalk, as required by the Department of Consumer Affairs. We also want to remind the applicant that Outdoor Weather Installations (Storm Enclosures) may not exceed 18 inches and have to be removed by April 15th. Please find appropriate rules and regulations attached.

On April 2, 2008 the Full Board voted to recommend approval of the application with the above stipulation.
