Dear Chairman Boyle:

At its March 11, 2008 meeting, the Business Licenses and Permits Committee of Manhattan Community Board 4 voted to recommend **denial** of a transfer of an existing Beer and Wine License for Daniel Kane or Entity to be formed – 149 Eighth Avenue (17/18) **unless the following stipulations**, agreed to by the applicant, **are part of the method of operation** for this establishment:

- Applicant will not apply for a cabaret license now or at any time in the future.
- French doors and windows will be closed by 10 p.m. Sunday-Thursday and 11 p.m. Friday-Saturday and not opened prior to 10 a.m. If there is any amplified music playing inside, the doors and windows will be closed at all times, as per the law.
- No outside promoters will be used

Daniel Kane or entity to be formed is a restaurant that will do

business as Chelsea Café, in the space formerly known as Food Bar, and be open seven days a week, 12 noon to 4 a.m. Total capacity is 149 with ten in the bar area, 75 in the dining room and ten at the food bar. The establishment will be operated primarily as a restaurant with full bar service.

At its full board meeting on April 2, 2008, Manhattan Community Board 4 voted to approve this recommendation.
