The cost of paying a commercial lease for months while waiting for City inspections can potentially put a small business out of business before it even opens its doors.

With angel and venture capital investors sitting on the sidelines, banks freezing much of their lending, and lines of credit being suspended, small business owners are under immense financial pressure. We believe our elected officials have an opportunity to ease this financial pressure, by streamlining the City inspection process.
