Manhattan Community Board 4 recommends approval of the application to renew the permit for an unenclosed sidewalk café submitted by the above applicant with the following stipulations:

- 1. Removal of 4 illegal sidewalk planters, 2 of which specifically block fire escape egresses and violate fire code;
- 2. Reduction of chairs in café setup from 18 to 16, making a configuration total of 8 Tables/16 chairs;
- 3. Demarcation of sidewalk café boundaries
- **4.** Submission of a diagram illustrating the café's new physical configuration, to be used as an addendum to the submitted blueprint illustrating the table reduction.

This was subsequent to a review of the site by the Quality of Life Committee and an appearance before the Committee by the applicant or a spokesperson for the applicant. No one appeared in opposition to the renewal and CB4 has no complaints on file regarding the above applicant.

We continue to request that the outer boundaries of cafes be marked on the sidewalk, as required by Department of Consumer Affair's sidewalk café regulations.
