Dear Commission Barrios-Pauli:

Manhattan Community Board 4 has serious concern regarding the arbitrary cuts in the funding for one of the better care providers for seniors in our District. We urge consideration for restoration of grants to at least the former level of support.

The cuts in funding which were announced during the December holidays are miniscule compared to the overall New York City budget. Described as 'non-core services', this small amount represents 1/3 of the annual operating income for **Visiting Neighbors**. Volunteers can make up the difference only in terms of time.

The effectiveness of the services which **Visiting Neighbors** provide for a base of over 300 seniors in District 4 is well documented. With an average age of 87, these seniors depend on the regular contact from **Visiting Neighbors** as their sole contact with the community.

The Board understands the difficulty all Departments in the City have in the current economic climate, but we urge that effective programs which provide direct services to the people be assured of continuing support.
