- This establishment will have background music only (no DJ or live bands).
- There are no plans to open a sidewalk café or use any outdoor space (rear patio). The delivery bikes will be stored on a bike rack near the front wall of this establishment during the daytime and in the basement at night.
- Hours of operation for the establishment are 11:30 am to $11: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ Sunday to Thursday and 11 am to midnight Friday and Saturday.
- Kitchen exhaust will be ventilated above the highest floor of the neighboring buildings and will be built to DOB code so as not to disturb the neighbors.

This establishment is a Thai restaurant and bar with at total capacity of 74 with a dining area capacity of 50.
