Dear Ms. Gotay:

Manhattan community Board 4 (CB4) recommends approval of the installation a 6' X 12' newsstand at the above location.

The newsstand owners accepted the responsibility for stowing all storage containers (even if owned by press companies) inside the stand during the day so that no press storage boxes will obstruct the sidewalk in the vicinity of the stand.

Another newsstand is located on the south East corner of 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue. CB4 deemed an exception to its internal guidelines of "no more than one newsstand within three blocs" is warranted because 23<sup>rd</sup> Street is a wide street that separates two distinct neighborhoods, and this location is especially appropriate for a newsstand. It does not impede pedestrian traffic and brings a new amenity to neighbors and passers by that was not available otherwise.
