## **500-Foot Public Interest Statement**

Applicant: TodosMex, LLC 103 W. 14<sup>th</sup> Street New York, NY

The proposed premises for the applicant is within 500-feet of three or more establishments selling liquor for on-premises consumption. This statement provides reasons in support of granting the license.

- A. The premises will be operated as a family oriented restaurant within New York City. Therefore, the licensing of this establishment will promote commerce within New York City and provide a family establishment for New York City residents.
- B. Prior to operation, all necessary licenses and permits will be obtained.
- C. Clientele for the premises is anticipated to draw primarily from patrons who are already shopping within New York City and as such the effect on vehicular traffic and parking in proximity to the location will not adversely affect the surrounding neighborhood. Moreover, the premises currently has a restaurant wine license application pending with the New York State Liquor Authority and we are merely seeking to upgrade same to On Premises Liquor. Thus, the upgrade to an On Premises Liquor license will have little affect in the surrounding neighborhood.
- D. The granting of this liquor license will have no negative impact on the neighborhood but will rather enhance the surrounding community by providing a family oriented restaurant and be a boom to the local commerce and tourism of the neighboring area.

For these and other reasons, an on-premises liquor license for this premises would be in the public interest and should be granted.
