Manhattan Community Board 4 (MCB4) recommends <u>denial</u> of a transfer of an On-Premise Liquor License for Morningside Terrace Corp -772 9th Avenue (51/52) <u>unless</u> the following stipulations, agreed to by the applicant, are part of the method of operation for this establishment with a capacity of less than 75 people, 16 tables with 54 seats, 1 stand-up bar with 16 seats and 6 tables in the front with 12 seats and 4 tables in the yard with 16 seats within building property line.

- ➢ No amplified live music
- Windows and doors will be closed at 10PM Sunday-Thursday and 11PM Friday and Saturday and whenever amplified music is played
- Continue to attend block associations and MNN meeting
- > Outdoor rear yard set up after 11AM and close at 8PM 7 days a week
- \blacktriangleright Reduce outdoor rear to 6 two tops
- ▶ Rear door will be closed and locked at 8PM
- Seated food service in rear
- Sound absorbing material, umbrellas, bushes in rear
- Come back in 6 months regarding Rear yard
- Sidewalk café included in license: 10 seats, 5 tables
