- There will be no amplified sound/music at the event. Public performance
 will take place between 1:30 and 3:30 p.m. The organizers will reach out to
 the New York City Police Department in advance of the event to make sure
 all security issues including crowd and traffic control are discussed and
 agreed to.

- Event organizers will make every effort to open the Rubin Museum for viewing at no charge to members of the public during the course of the event.
- Will work with Department of Sanitation regarding all clean-up issues associated with the Street Fair. Organizers commit to the goal of leaving the street cleaner at the end of the event than how they found it on the morning of.
