On May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2017 the Arts, Culture, Education & Street Life Committee ("ACES") of Manhattan Community Board 4 ("CB4"), reviewed an application from Infirnity Inc, for a Single Block Party event to be held on July 1, 2017 between the hours of 12pm-5pm.

The Committee voted to recommend that the Street Activity Permit Office ("SAPO") approve this application. Infirnity Inc., represented by Lisa Jasienowski, is a non-profit organization focused on mentoring young men ages 9-19 through its sports program.

The Event, to be held on West 26<sup>th</sup> Street between 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> Avenues, is directly in front of the Hudson Guild Community Center in the Elliot Chelsea Houses. The CB4 district office confirmed that the NYCHA Elliot Chelsea Tenant Association and the Hudson Guild support the event.

The Committee did recommend that the organizer speak continue to coordinate the event activities with both the Tenant Association and the Hudson Guild.
